
## NOTE FROM MICHAEL


professionalism and commitment to providing outstanding service. I wish Shawn, wife Megan and young daughter Peyton all the best!

Some of the agronomic processes that we have to perform include fertilization, and snow mold prevention. A lot of what we will be doing will help the golf course next year. Contrary to popular belief, we don't really slow down when the weather gets cooler but rather just transition into a different type of maintenance mode.

Through the winter months we will be performing service on our equipment and golf course accessories, installing drainage, as well as harvesting and pruning declining or hazardous trees. All of our winter maintenance helps to aid in a successful golf season.

As I mentioned last year, the Club offers wonderful cross country skiing trails that we groom daily, as long as the temperatures are below freezing, throughout the winter. The trails are routed throughout the golf course and, when possible, through certain sections of the woods.

We will continue to prepare the golf course for daily play through the late fall and early winter should we continue to have good golf weather. If you have any questions or comments please do not hesitate to contact me.
